Coming soon to the Defiance Catholic community is our 8th season of Generations of Faith, a Church-centered, lifelong, intergenerational faith formation approach designed to promote learning by participating and experiencing. I'm excited to announce this year's theme, *GOT PRAYER?*

Also, right around the corner is our Generations of Faith Kick-off which will feature Fr. Herb Weber's presentation, "Lord, Teach Us to Pray." This year the kick-off is a one-evening event to be held on Wednesday, September 14 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. at the Knights of Columbus Hall. 6. **SHARE** your excitement about Generations of Faith with your family and friends, and,
7. **INVITE** others every chance you get to come to Generations of Faith...a place where learning together is invigorating, challenging, needed and necessary.

That's it, then. And I'm thanking you in advance for choosing to keep learning, living and loving your faith...at home, at work, at school and everywhere. We are all called to live the Catholic vocation and Generations of Faith is a wonderful way to help you answer that call!
